Get the Work

When you know ahead of time that your child will be missing class, give the school plenty of notice so he/she can provide makeup work to do. If your child is out unexpectedly, due to illness or other reasons, in addition to contacting the school office, make arrangements with your child's teacher to pick up a packet of work from the school. If the absence is lengthy (e.g. for surgery), alert teachers and administration as soon as you know and get updated assignments as the days go on. We are here to work with you!

Important Reminders

Report In

Schools are required to track attendance of every child, in every classroom, everyday. The state of South Dakota requires schools to hit a certain percentage of daily attendance and that number hovers around 94%. We realize that appointments are needed and scheduled months in advance and we live hours away from doctors, etc. It is essential that you always contact the school if your child is going to be late for class, will need an early dismissal, or will be absent.

*NOTE: In regards to activities, a doctor note will be required if a student/athlete is missing school the day of a game or activity for any medical appointment. If a note is <u>not</u> provided, they will not be able to participate.



Vacation Plans

It's tempting to pull your kids from school for a lengthy family trip, but it is not ideal. Why? When they miss class work, even if you ask for make-up work to be sent ahead of time, they can fall behind because they're missing many hours of instructional time each day. Instead of thinking of how you can miss the crowds by taking trips during the school year, think about what it could be costing your child.

School Lunch Information

School lunches will be paid again this year. Elementary meals are \$3.75 and MS/HS meals are \$4.25. Meals are \$0.40/each for all K-12 students who qualify for reduced price meals.

These applications are used for more than determining eligibility for free and reduced-price meals. They can help us receive more grant funding and other federal assistance and keep kids qualified for the next school year.


